

WCA Competition Announcement Policy

Version 2.0

Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to create an Advisory Committee with the responsibility and duty of approving and announcing WCA Competitions.

Policy

The WCA Board hereby creates the WCA Competition Announcement Team (WCAT) as an Advisory Committee of the WCA.

1. The WCA Competition Announcement Team is responsible for announcing WCA Competitions.
2. The WCA Competition Announcement Team has the following rights and duties:
 - 2.1 Announcing WCA Competitions:
 - 2.1.1 Approving and announcing WCA Competitions (See Motion 4.2018.1, Article 2.7).
 - 2.1.1.1 Ensuring announcements adhere to WCA quality standards.
 - 2.1.2 Rejecting competitions.
 - 2.1.3 Making exceptions to the WCA Competition Proximity Policy.
 - 2.1.4 Approving the adoption of optional regulations by organization teams to facilitate the administration of competitions (WCA Regulations Article Z; WCA Regulation 9k).
 - 2.2 Editing WCA Competitions:
 - 2.2.1 Editing WCA Competitions after they have been announced, at the request of the WCA Delegate(s).
 - 2.2.2 Approving changes to competitor limits (See WCA Regulation Z4b).
 - 2.3 Deleting WCA Competitions:
 - 2.3.1 Deleting and removing the announcements of WCA Competitions that have been cancelled by the WCA Board.

The WCA Board retains the right to override or revert competition announcements made under the WCA Competition Announcement Team's authority.
